The 2012 SWIM Across the Sound was canceled due to inclement weather in Port Jefferson, NY. The Contingency Course was set in Blackrock Harbor using a two-mile loop (5 loops) for solo swimmers and two person relays and one-mile loop for relays.

The SWIM was called due to torrential downpours. Greg Sargent led the solo swimmers near the end of his third loop. Greg was followed by two female swimmers - Marcy MacDonald and Nicole Hirschman. Jim Bayles and Chris Slawsky were equally paced with Tibor Molnar slightly behind while Krystal Daymonde, Ed Daymonde and Bethany Bosch swam together, steady and strong.

The leading team relays almost made it through the six transitions. Westport Wave and NYAC Red Tide were neck and neck but visibility made it impossible to identify a clear winner.
